We have a **POSITION OPEN** for District 2 Representative to the **NATA Connection and Engagement Committee**.

What is CEC?

The Connection and Engagement Committee (CEC) is composed of members with a keen interest in engaging and connecting ATs with resources and information available to them from the national office. This person will help to facilitate information and feedback up and down the association chain at all levels; National, District, State, and Local, and be an Ambassador for the NATA Brand and profession. In addition, the D2 CEC Rep will work with the D2 Executive Council to create promotional ideas as well as oversee our social media administrators and create content.

What are the Duties of the CEC?

1. Disseminate and promote general national information.
2. Increase and promote awareness and participation of ATs at the state, district, and national levels.
3. Facilitate communication between the District 2 and D2 State Leaders
4. Promote and recognize National, District, and State awards of our D2 members.

Qualifications:

1. NATA and D2 Member in Good Standing
2. BOC Certified and in Good Standing
3. National Provider Identification (NPI) Number
4. Current license in good standing in state(s) of practice

NOT REQUIRED, but knowledge in the D2 Social Media Platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Linked In and Instagram)

Responsibilities:

1. Term will begin June 2021(VNATA)
2. Attendance at the JCM (beginning January 2022) and NATA Annual Meeting (beginning June 2022) throughout the term.
3. Actively participation in CEC Conference calls throughout the year.
4. Regular interaction with state presidents in the district.
5. Work with our state PR representatives whenever possible to assist on facilitating information.
6. Distribute information from the NATA Office, D2 Leadership, and State Associations
7. Create content and work with D2 Social Media Administrators.
8. Promote D2, State Associations, NATA, and athletic training in creative ways for use on our Social Media Platforms.

D2 CEC Representative Selection

D2 Candidates will be evaluated by the D2 District Director and NATA CEC Chair. A phone interview may be a part of the process.

NATA-D2 CEC Representative Term

The D2 CEC Chair serves a one-year term renewable up to a total of four year of service.
